### Retention Rates, Licensure Pass Rates, and Career Placement Rates, 2023 -2024

Hondros College of Nursing provides the following data according to requirements established by the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools (SBCCS). Unless otherwise noted, the rates below are those reported to the College’s institutional accreditor, the Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools (ABHES), using the formula established by ABHES.

#### Retention Rate

**Note:** The Ohio Board of Nursing (OBN) calculates licensure pass rates differently from ABHES. The OBN reports the number of individuals who pass the NCLEX-PN or NCLEX-RN examination on the *first* attempt throughout each calendar year. Additionally, the OBN’s reported licensure pass rate combines all Hondros College of Nursing campuses in Ohio into a single calculation. The OBN’s official pass rates for the College’s Ohio campuses are indicated in the following table.
